

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we all know we are having to alter the way of teaching children over the coming weeks and months. In school we work really hard to ensure every child learns to read as quickly as possible, the success in reading unlocks all other learning. As a school, we use RWInc where your child has an hour lessons daily, in ability groups where they focus on a different sound each day. They begin by reading the sound, words containing the sound and then write words containing the same sound, along with other book activities.

Read Write Inc have set up a YouTube account where they are streaming daily Read Write Inc 'speed sound lessons' for at least the next 2 weeks. Each YouTube film is available for the next 24 hours. I strongly recommend that you access this fantastic resource to help your child progress with their reading. It will also provide an insight into how reading is currently taught at PSM.

All children in Foundation are currently on set 2 or were due to start set 2 sounds after Easter. All children in yr 1 are working with set 2 and set 3 sounds.
