

Science

This term we will be learning about Earth and Space which will include the movement of the Earth and Moon, day and night and seasons. We will also learn about Forces including air and water resistance, gravity and friction.

History and Geography

Children will learn where Greece is and how the Ancient Greeks lived. They will hear the famous story of The Trojan Horse and examine evidence to decide if this is true. They will learn about Greek Gods and the first Olympic Games as well as the foundations of Democracy.

Design and Technology

Children will find out about the foods eaten in Greece using the Internet to research this information. They will taste Greek Foods and give their opinions on the different tastes and textures.

Modern Foreign Languages

We will continue to expand our French vocabulary so that we are able to ask basic questions and answer in short phrases. This will be done through singing and playing simple games in French.

Ancient Greece

This term we will be looking at Greek Theatre and in particular the masks worn. Children will make observational drawings, design and create masks using paper mache and adding 3D details. These will then be used in a performance of Perseus and the Medusa.

Religious Education

The unit has a particular focus on key values in religion and develops children's own ideas of what really matters to them in terms of values, relationships and emotions. Children will learn about Buddhism and Christianity describe the key aspects of religions, especially the people, stories and traditions which influence beliefs and values.

Physical Education

This term we will be taking part in Argyle's Joy of moving project. They will also be Spinning and Turning in Gym using different axes.

In addition, we will practice striking and fielding skills and incorporate these into rounders type activities and develop a range of Athletics skills.

Computing

Our computing this term is creating a virtual Art Gallery. Children will also use Word and Powerpoint to produce information linked to our Ancient Greek theme. Children will be taught about e-safety as part of all Computing lessons.
