

## Religious Education

In Religious Education next term we will be learning about Teaching and Authority within Christianity and Hinduism. We will be introducing the children to sacred texts to explore the meanings both in their own lives and within the lives of Christians and Hindus.

## Physical Education

Children will develop their athletic skills through sessions delivered by specialist coaches. We will continue to develop our fundamental movements focusing on counter balances, co-ordinator, reaction and dynamic balance. We will be taking part in orienteering activities to develop our outdoor adventure skills.

## Science

This term in science we will build on our knowledge of plants. We will begin by looking at the parts of a plant and the role they have. We will learn about the life cycle of a plant. In our Animals including humans topic we will look at the requirements needed to lead a healthy life style and begin to understand how our skeleton and muscles work together so we can move. We will continue to work scientifically by researching, comparing and sorting, and observing investigations over time.

## Computing

In computing we will be learning how the internet works and different ways we can communicate using technology. We will continue to use the internet safely, making ourselves and other aware how we can stay safe online.

## Music

This term we will explore a variety of theme based rhythms, beats and songs. We will also be learning songs to perform in our end of year production.

## Geography

Our learning this term will cover The Amazon Rain forest. We will be learning about life in the rainforests, including animals and plants, the climate, the landscape and deforestation. We will develop our mapping skills and geographical questioning, as well as build on our current knowledge of physical and human geography. We will also touch upon the traditions of tribes living in the rainforest.

## Design Technology

Our area of focus for this term's DT will be food. We will be analysing existing bread based products with fillings that would be suitable for a school lunchbox. We will develop our cutting, grating and spreading techniques using a range of utensils. Following our making, we will evaluate our final products.

## Art

This term we will be experimenting with patterns and intrinsic designs inspired by the Amazon Rain forest. We will also study the work of Henri Rousseau and develop our own images inspired by his work.

## Modern Foreign Languages

Children will enjoy finding out about life, language and culture in France. We will listen and respond to simple words, phrases and rhymes. We will learn songs and begin to write in French.
